COVID-19 Student Guidance

The health and safety of students throughout their learning experience at St. Anthony is among our primary concerns. Clinical assignments for students will not include the direct care or service to the patient with COVID-19 suspected or confirmed infection.

Students will complete a review of infection prevention practices and demonstration of PPE use as a component of the facility orientation.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Face masks must be worn at all times in patient care areas while on St. Anthony campus.
 - If unvaccinated, you may not remove your mask while at St. Anthony unless you are eating or on a break in your designated area.
 - If vaccinated, you may remove your mask when in non-patient care areas, such as non-clinical offices and break rooms.
