In 2006, the No One Dies Alone (NODA) program began at St. Anthony Regional Hospital and Nursing Home. In its beginning, 36 employees volunteered for the ministry. As of today, the ministry has grown to 80 employees. The Carroll and surrounding area has a rich tradition that is known for its family support and because of that, the ministry has not been activated often. However when NODA has been activated, St. Anthony employees have been very faithful in responding to meet the needs of the dying by offering their presence in times of need.

Communication and team work makes the NODA ministry so successful. This ministry is one of several opportunities that St. Anthony staff demonstrate by action, the legacy that the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration have asked us to carry on.

Interested employees who wish to become a member of this volunteer ministry attend a one hour training to learn the protocol and guidelines to be a NODA volunteer. Declining a flu vaccine means you will need to complete a Health Stream assignment and you must wear a mask from October 31-March 31.

If you are declining the flu shot, you must sign a declination form by October 31st.
