This addition to the St. Anthony Spiritual Care Department will enhance service offerings currently provided by Peg Scheidt, who had retired but returned to St. Anthony this past September to serve as part-time chaplain.

“I am excited to begin this chapter in my life, serving the patients, residents and staff at St. Anthony,” Angelo said. “When I came to visit the hospital and community here in Carroll, everything felt right. Each individual I encountered was accommodating and friendly. I knew this is where I wanted to be. This opportunity arose in Carroll – and I’ve found that whenever I follow God’s whisper, things work out pretty well.”

Angelo comes to St. Anthony from Iowa Methodist Medical Center, UnityPoint Health in Des Moines, where he completed his residency as chaplain. He has demonstrated a passion for helping others in various roles throughout his career, including serving three years with Catholic Charities in Chicago.

Born in the Philippines, Angelo and his family immigrated to Chicago when he was 7-years-old. He earned his bachelor’s degree in music education from Elmhurst College in Elmhurst, Ill., and spent time traveling the world, which led him to ministry. The Auxiliary also provides scholarships to students from Carroll, Kuemper and Des Moines Area Community College who are pursuing nursing education.
