St. Anthony Registered Nurse, Quality Management Professional Randi Boell graduated from the Iowa Hospital Association's Quality Residency Program. Boell was one of 13 health care quality professionals from across the state to complete the two year program, designed to provide knowledge, support and networking opportunities that position quality leaders for success.



A native and current resident of Carroll, Boell has served St. Anthony for a cumulative tenure of 10 years.

“Through this program, I have received a lot of information and resources while developing a better understanding to the diverse roles quality professionals have. It’s not just about regulations, data and working with insurance companies – clinical experience, judgement and ensuring patient safety are also key. As quality professionals, we work diligently to maintain compliance and patient safety at every point,” Boell said. “There is always something new to learn in this ever-changing industry. Sound clinical judgment, adaptability and the desire for continuous improvement are key skills in this role.”

Through the program, participants attended 10 full-day, in-person learning sessions on topics including: quality improvement, use of data, meeting external requirements, patient safety tools, survey and accreditation, medical staff functions, risk management and patient and family engagement. The curriculum also included pre- and post-online learning assessments and interactive discussion among these quality professionals in the program.
