## St. Anthony Foundation Announces \$7 Million Capital Campaign *Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration Donate Cornerstone Gift*



On Wednesday, February 27, 2019, the St. Anthony Foundation announced a \$7 million capital campaign for a new regional cancer center, which will serve hundreds of residents each year in west central Iowa. The capital campaign will fund a significant portion of the \$16.5 million project recently approved by the St. Anthony Board of Directors.

“This is a catalyst moment for our region and community,” said Ed Smith, President and CEO, St. Anthony Regional Hospital. “The capital campaign is an investment in a new facility and a continuation of our high-quality cancer care. More importantly it demonstrates our commitment to providing care close to home for those battling cancer.”

Smith explains that St. Anthony, along with medical and radiation oncologists, will partner with health care providers to offer seamless, patient-centered care in the facility to individuals fighting cancer.

### Cornerstone Gift

The Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration (FSPA) presented the St. Anthony Foundation with a cornerstone gift of \$2.5 million.

“We are pleased to be the first, major gift of the campaign,” said Sister Helen Elsbernd, Honorary Chair. “We believe it is important to invest in this region and the new regional cancer center will bring health, healing and hope to those facing cancer.”

Smith also acknowledged the significance of the FSPA gift.

“St. Anthony is grateful to the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration for their unwavering support and passion for our mission. Their generous gift provides a solid foundation for this project and we hope to build on this momentum throughout the region,” said Smith.
